2008 PROJECT RULES

**RESPECT IS NOT REQUESTED... IT IS EXPECTED!**

This applies to every contestant towards fellow model contestants, volunteers, workshop leaders – basically everyone you come in contact with during the project process.

1. Models/contestants must bring valid proof of age and recent photo identification with them to all workshops and events related to the project. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
2. The contest is open to Canadian citizens and permanent residents who are male, gay, of ages 19+ as of January 4th, 2008 and residing within the Greater Vancouver region.
3. Models must make themselves available for the official workshop dates of: Sunday, January 20 and Sunday, February 17, as well as the final show Thursday, March 6, 2008. Also, additional dates for photo shoots will be booked with photographer and models that move forward in the competition.
4. “DRESS TO IMPRESS”; think of all workshops as “AUDITIONS”. You may also want to bring extra comfortable clothing for when you are not in photo shoots where you will be working up a sweat (exercise, and movement choreography are part of the workshops).
5. Personal cameras, video cameras, etc. are accepted in and around the workshop and performance venues with the exception of dressing rooms and washrooms. Personal cameras cannot interfere with professional cameras (project related and accredited media).
6. The models are **NOT ALLOWED TO BRING GUESTS** to these workshops/auditions but are encouraged to bring as many as they can to the final event March 6, 2008, by purchasing tickets.
7. Finalists will be required to prepare a one-minute performance piece entirely on their own (be creative). Clothing for the final show will be arranged by the models and potential sponsors.
8. Models entering the competition with a prior management contract of any kind; including modelling, entertainment related etc. must disclose of such. Also, if a model is chosen as a finalist, your management company must provide a letter acknowledging the fact that you are a volunteer participant, from January to April 2008 – the complete process of this project.
9. Footage (photos and video) taken by the models during the process of the contest are for personal use only; this includes posting on websites, etc with no commercial venture.
10. All footage taken by media is for promotional purposes only.
11. All footage gathered by the project producing team is for the use on all project-related materials that come attached with the name *Vancouver's Next Gay Top Model*, including but not restricted to broadcasting, publishing and promotional materials. The footage can only be used up to a maximum of two years from the events date; after that, no new products will be produced, with the images gathered from this project, without the consent of the model.
12. Anyone, outside the producing team, must have prior written permission to use photos or any other footage of this project for commercial ventures.
